I, GLORIA McDOUGALL, a person over eighteen years of age and competent to testify, being duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

- I was formerly employed as an official court reporter for the State of Idaho, and worked with Idaho County District Court Judge George Reinhardt.

2. I was Judge Reinhardt's court reporter during the proceedings for Mark and Bryan Lankford on their murder cases in Idaho County. To the best of my recollection, I reported on all proceedings in those cases except the sentencing.
3. I spent a lot of time with Judge Reinhardt in the court room. We also traveled together to other court houses in Lewis County and Nez Perce County.
4. During the Lankford proceedings, after the preliminary hearing and before the trials, I recall that Judge Reinhardt made numerous comments to me about how he was looking forward to giving Mark and Bryan Lankford the death penalty. At the time, I was shocked to hear these comments and thought they were highly inappropriate.
5. Judge Reinhardt appeared to have his mind made up about sentencing both of the Lankfords to death before he ever heard any testimony. He subsequently sentenced both of them to death.
6. I also had the impression, based on the time I spent with the judge, that he was excited about the prospect of sentencing people to death. It was something that he looked forward to doing.
7. I recall an occasion when a man was caught burglarizing a property where the property owner allowed Judge Reinhardt to hunt. This defendant was brought before the judge. The judge announced in open court the relationship he had with the property owner, but assured everyone he could be fair and impartial and all parties agreed to go forward with Judge Reinhardt. Afterward, I was in my office with Sue Storm, the presentence investigator, and Judge Reinhardt came and

instructed Sue to find everything she could on the defendant because Judge Reinhardt wanted to "hang" him.

- 8. I have worked as a court reporter now for almost twenty-eight years. Judge Reinhardt is the most unprofessional judge I have worked with or observed.
